CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- This show is for Pinto horses only. Horses MUST be registered & the owner a current financial member of the NZ Pinto Horse Society Inc at close of entries. This is excluding the Leisure section.**
- Age of horse is recognised as 1st August. Age of Rider/Handler as of date of the show
- It is recommended you have a current Life or NZ RAS Height Certificate for the 2017/2018 Show Season. Led Youngstock Horses to mature over 148cm (2 years & under) do not require them. No measuring available on the day. Failure to produce a current certificate if asked may result in elimination with no refund.
- ALL** riders must wear protective headgear, which meets current RAS standards and be red tagged, at all times while riding.
- ALL Colts/Stallions – 12 months & over
Must be shown in a bridle & bit. Miniatures in a halter & chain
All stallions/colts, except foals, to wear 2 official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle/halter at all times
Handlers & Riders must also wear two RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring
Handlers & Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest when outside the showing ring
An attendant 17 years or over in addition to the handler/rider to remain on standby at all times
Pony Stallions must be ridden by riders 14 years & over also refer Novice pony rule. Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider 17 years of age or older
No colts/stallions are to be left unattended or tied to floats/trucks at anytime while on the show grounds
An official can order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor
Colts/stallions will be eliminated with no refund given if the above rule is not adhered
- Green Pony/Horse must NOT have won a 1st or 2nd in a Novice, Best Registered Pinto or Open class in any section at close of entries
- Novice has not had more than 5 wins in a conformation class or Best Registered Pinto class. Novice wins in any section include all A&P shows, RAS affiliated shows, HOY & NZ Pinto Horse Soc Shows at close of entries. **Snaffle bits only**. Novices are eligible to enter Open classes. There will be no waiting if you change from a snaffle to a double bridle for the Open class
- Novice** Ponies can be ridden by riders over 17 years in the Pony section in all the classes excluding Open. They are not eligible for the Open Championship if ridden by a rider over 17 years of age. **Open** ponies must be ridden by riders 17 years & under in all classes. No change of rider is allowed once the section has started
- Protests must be accompanied by a \$50 deposit, refundable if the protest is sustained & submitted no later than half an hour after the incident that gave rise to the protest
- No Dogs** permitted on the grounds, failure to comply will result in disqualification with no refund
- The NZPtHS Committee reserves the right to alter/delete the programme as it sees fit
- Any competitor found mistreating a horse, competing a horse deemed to be lame by the judge, arguing/fighting or being abusive to other competitors, judges or officials will be eliminated with no refund and asked to leave the grounds immediately
- In the event of sickness or injury, 75% of entry fees will be refunded if a Vet or Doctors certificate is produced to the Show Secretary within 7 days of the competition. No other refunds will be made

14. NZPtHS accept no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to Property, Horse, Handler/Rider or Spectator
15. Back numbers not returned will be charged \$20. If yards are left uncleaned \$25 penalty fee will be charged
16. Supreme of Show Inhand & Ridden winners, if they are competing at the HOY show 2018 in the Pinto section, will receive petrol vouchers towards the cost of attending. If the winner is within 100kms of the HOY show, they will receive \$100 (cap of \$150 per horse), 100-200kms from HOY, \$200 (cap \$300 per horse) and more than 200kms from HOY, \$300 (cap of \$450 per horse). A copy of the receipt of your HOY entry must be provided to the Society Secretary before vouchers are issued. Not transferable to any other horse. If the horse entered doesn't compete on the day the petrol vouchers must be refunded within 7 days unless the committee decides otherwise
17. Any Lapels, Badges, Rugs or similar that identify previous awards won are banned from being worn on the rider/handler or horse/pony in or near the ring
18. You can enter either Show Horse or Saddle Hunter not both with the same horse

The ratio for Judgement is 60/40. 60% being conformation and soundness, 40% being manners, paces and education

A Show Horse should show quality, elegance and gaiety with very good paces. Each must be well mannered without a loss of natural exuberance and be capable of giving a rider a pleasant easy ride.

A Saddle Hunter should have substance, be active and well mannered with strong easy paces. These horses must be capable of carrying weight is relevant allocations for long distances over varied country. Each must have excellent galloping paces, which must be demonstrated in the work out

INHAND SECTION

Pinto Pony not to exceed 148cm and Miniature under 38inches

Miniature Horses do not have to be registered with a Miniature Horse Society

If less than 6 Miniature Horse entries are received then the classes will be combined with ponies

11. Pony Mare 4 years & over
12. Pony Stallion or Gelding 4 years & over

Champion & Reserve Adult Miniature *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 9 & 10, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

Champion & Reserve Adult Pony *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 11 & 12, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

Supreme Champion Miniature *judged from Champion winners of Youngstock & Adult. To go forward for Supreme of Show at end of Inhand section*

Supreme Champion Pony *judged from Champion winners of Youngstock & Adult. To go forward for Supreme of Show at end of Inhand section*

13. Junior Handler 15 years & under *any height horse*

Classes 14 & 15, horses must be registered with the NZGCA or any foals born after 1 August 2016 must be eligible for registration with the NZGCA, and the owner must be a current financial member of the NZGCA

25. Show Horse 4 years & over, not to exceed 158cm
26. Show Horse 4 years & over, over 158cm

Champion & Reserve Adult Show Horse *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 25 & 26, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

Supreme Champion Horse *judged from Champion winners of Youngstock & Adults. To go forward for Supreme of Show at end of Inhand section*

Supreme Inhand Champion of the Show *Judged from Inhand Supreme winners*

RIDDEN SECTION

40 minutes will be given from judging of Supreme to the start of the Ridden sections

No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged

34. Best Purebred Pinto Gypsy Cob any *Champion & Reserve sashes, judged as an Open class*

35. Best Partbred Pinto Gypsy Cob any height *Champion & Reserve sashes, judged as an Open class*

Classes 34 & 35, horses must be registered with the NZGCA and the owner must be a current financial member of the NZGCA

Champion Best Presented *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 27, 36 & 47*

37. Rider over 18 years

40. Novice Saddle Hunter 0 to 5 wins *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*

Leisure Horse – any height

This section is aimed at Pony Club types or horses not suitable for the Open show ring, **NOT** show/dressage horses or green show horses. Jackets & plaiting are optional. Conformation is not considered. **Snaffle bits only.** Adults can ride ponies in this section. Lead rein ponies to be led by a person over 17 years & can enter classes 47 to 50 & 54. Not eligible for Supreme Ridden. Does not count as a Qualification win for the HOY show. Height certificates are NOT required.

Unregistered horses and non-members can enter this section ONLY. This is a one-off opportunity as the same horse will not be able to compete again unless registered and owner a financial member at subsequent shows. Please read through attached conditions for this section.

No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged

48. Rider any age *this section only*
