CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. This show is for Pinto horses only. Horses MUST be registered & the owner a current financial member of the NZ Pinto Horse Society Inc at close of entries**
- 2. Plaiting Optional**
- 3. Back numbers are to be supplied by the competitor. NO back numbers available on the day**
4. Age of horse is recognised as 1st August. Age of Rider/Handler as of date of the show
5. It is recommended you have a current Life or NZ RAS Height Certificate for the 2017/2018 Show Season. Led Youngstock Horses to mature over 148cm (2 years & under) do not require them. No measuring available on the day. Failure to produce a current certificate if asked may result in elimination with no refund
6. **ALL** riders must wear protective head gear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at two or more points at all times while riding
7. ALL Colts/Stallions – 12 months & over
Must be shown in a bridle & bit. Miniatures in a halter & chain
To wear 2 official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle/halter at all times, with the exception of foals
Handlers & Riders must also wear two RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring
An attendant 17 years or over in addition to the handler/rider to remain on standby at all times
Pony Stallions must be ridden by riders 14 years & over also refer Novice pony rule. Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider 17 years of age or older
No colts/stallions are to be left unattended or tied to floats/trucks at anytime while on the show grounds
An official can order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor
Colts/stallions will be eliminated with no refund given if the above rule is not adhered
8. Green Pony/Horse walking & trotting only. Must NOT have won a Ridden 1st or 2nd in a Novice, Best Registered Pinto or Open class in any section at close of entries
9. Novice has not had more than 5 wins in a conformation class or Best Registered Pinto class. Novice wins in any section include all RAS affiliated shows, Premier show, NZ National Showcase Championships, HOY & NZ Pinto Horse Soc Shows at close of entries.
Snaffle bits only. Novices are eligible to enter Open classes. There will be no waiting if you change from a snaffle to a double bridle for the Open class
10. **Novice** Ponies can be ridden by riders over 17 years in the Pony section in all the classes excluding Open. They are not eligible for the Open Championship if ridden by a rider over 17 years of age. **Open** ponies must be ridden by riders 17 years & under in all classes. No change of rider is allowed once the section has started
11. Protests must be accompanied by a \$50 deposit, refundable if the protest is sustained & submitted no later than half an hour after the incident that gave rise to the protest
12. **No Dogs** permitted on the grounds, failure to comply will result in disqualification with no refund
13. The NZPtHS Committee reserves the right to alter/delete the programme as they see fit
14. Any competitor or spectator found mistreating a horse, competing a horse deemed to be lame by the judge, arguing/fighting or being abusive to other competitors, judges or officials will be eliminated with no refund & asked to leave the grounds immediately. This includes ringside behaviour
15. In the event of sickness or injury, 75% of total entry fees will be refunded if a qualified Veterinarian or Doctors certificate ONLY is produced to the Show Secretary within 5 working days of the competition. No other refunds will be made
16. NZPtHS accept no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to Property, Horse, Handler/Rider or Spectator
17. \$700 worth of petrol vouchers for Supreme of Show Inhand & Ridden winners with a cap of \$1050 for one horse if they are competing at the HOY show 2018 in the Pinto section. A copy of the receipt of your HOY entry must be provided to the Society Secretary before vouchers are issued. Not transferable to any other horse. If the horse entered doesn't compete on the day the petrol vouchers must be refunded within 7 days unless the committee decides otherwise

18. Any Lapels, Badges, Rugs or similar that identify previous awards won are banned from being worn on the rider/handler or horse/pony in or near the ring
 19. No Temporary pens around floats/trucks. Please contact Canterbury A&P direct if you would like to book a stable
 20. To be held wet or fine.
 21. The ratio for Judgement is 60/40. 60% being conformation and soundness, 40% being manners, paces and education
 22. You can enter either Show Horse or Hunter not both with the same horse
- Show Horse** should show quality, elegance and gaiety with very good paces. Each must be well mannered without a loss of natural exuberance and be capable of giving a rider a pleasant easy ride.

Saddle Hunter should have substance, be active and well mannered with strong easy paces. These horses must be capable of carrying weight is relevant allocations for long distances over varied country. Each must have excellent galloping paces, which must be demonstrated in the work out

2. Best Presented Miniature & Handler *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*
No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged
3. Best Colour & Pattern *judged on markings exhibited only*
4. Best Walking
5. Best Trotting
6. Miniature Youngstock Horse *3 years & under, 38 inches & under*
7. Pony Foal or Yearling *to mature over 38 inches but under 148cm*
8. Pony 2 or 3 year old *to mature over 38 inches but under 148cm*

Champion & Reserve Youngstock Miniature/Pony *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 6, 7 & 8, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

9. Miniature Horse 4 years & over *38 inches & under*
10. Saddle Hunter 4 years & over
11. Show Pony 4 years & over

Champion & Reserve Adult Miniature/Pony *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 9, 10 & 11, 2nd placegetters to stand by*
Supreme Champion Miniature/Pony *judged from Champion winners of Youngstock & Adult. To go forward for Supreme of Show at end of Inhand section*

12. Junior Handler 15 years & under *any height horse*

Classes 13 & 14, horses must be registered with the NZGCA or any foals born after 1 August 2017 must be eligible for registration with the NZGCA, and the owner must be a current financial member of the NZGCA. Open to solid coloured and Pinto horses. These are NZGCA HOY 2018 qualifying classes

13. Best Purebred Pinto Gypsy Cob any height *Champion & Reserve sashes*
14. Best Partbred Pinto Gypsy Cob any height *Champion & Reserve sashes*

INHAND Pinto Saddle Hunter over 148cm

15. Best Presented Saddle Hunter & Handler *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*
No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged
16. Best Colour & Pattern *judged on markings exhibited only*
17. Best Walking
18. Best Trotting
19. Foal or Yearling *to mature over 148cm*
20. 2 or 3 year old *to mature over 148cm*

Champion & Reserve Youngstock Horse *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 19 & 20, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

21. Saddle Hunter 4 years & over, not to exceed 158cm
22. Saddle Hunter 4 years & over, over 158cm

Champion & Reserve Adult Saddle Hunter *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 21 & 22, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

INHAND Pinto Show Horse over 148cm

23. Best Presented Show Horse & Handler *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*
No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged
24. Best Colour & Pattern *judged on markings exhibited only*
25. Best Walking
26. Best Trotting
27. Foal or Yearling *to mature over 148cm*
28. 2 or 3 year old *to mature over 148cm*

Champion & Reserve Youngstock Horse *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 27 & 28, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

29. Show Horse 4 years & over, not to exceed 158cm
30. Show Horse 4 years & over, over 158cm

Champion & Reserve Adult Show Horse *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 29 & 30, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

Supreme Champion Horse *judged from Champion winners of Youngstock & Adults in Saddle Hunter & Show Horse sections. To go forward for Supreme of Show at end of Inhand section*

After completion of the Inhand sections SUPREME OF SHOW *judged from Inhand Supreme winners*

RIDDEN SECTION

40 minutes will be given from judging of Supreme to the start of the Ridden sections

RIDDEN Pony not to exceed 148cm

31. Best Presented Horse & Rider *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*

No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged

32. Rider 17 years & under

33. Green Pony *walking & trotting only*

34. Best Mannered

35. Best Paced

36. Novice 0 to 5 wins *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice. No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged*

37. Open Saddle Hunter

38. Open Show Pony

Champion & Reserve Pony *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 36, 37 & 38, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

Classes 39 & 40, horses must be registered with the NZGCA and the owner must be a current financial member of the NZGCA. Open to solid coloured and Pinto horses. These are NZGCA HOY 2018 qualifying classes

39. Best Purebred Pinto Gypsy Cob any height *Champion & Reserve sashes, judged as an Open class*

40. Best Partbred Pinto Gypsy Cob any height *Champion & Reserve sashes, judged as an Open class*

RIDDEN Pinto over 148cm

41. Best Presented Horse & Rider *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*

No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged

42. Rider over 18 years

43. Green Horse *walking & trotting only*

44. Best Paced & Mannered Show Horse

45. Best Paced & Mannered Saddle Hunter

46. Novice Show Horse 0 to 5 wins *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*

47. Novice Saddle Hunter 0 to 5 wins *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Novice*

Champion Novice *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 36, 46 & 47*

48. Open Show Horse

49. Open Saddle Hunter

Champion & Reserve Show Horse *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 46 & 48, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

Champion & Reserve Saddle Hunter *judged from 1st placegetters in classes 47 & 49, 2nd placegetters to stand by*

After completion of Ridden Pony & Horse sections

SUPREME OF SHOW *judged from Champion Pony, Show Horse & Saddle Hunter*

RIDDEN Pleasure Horse any height, no height certificates are required in this section. Will be held outside if weather permits.

This section is aimed at Pony Club types or horses not suitable for the Open show ring, NOT show/dressage horses or green show horses. Open to any height. Jackets are optional. Conformation is not considered. **Snaffle bits only.** Adults can ride ponies in this section. Not eligible for Supreme Ridden. Does not count as a Qualification win for the HOY show

50. Best Presented Horse & Rider *1st placegetter to go forward for Champion Best Presented*

No other classes will proceed until Champion has been judged

51. Rider any age *this section only*

52. Best Walking

53. Pleasure Horse

54. Best Mannered

55. One Hand Bandit – *ride with one hand on your head*

56. Handy Horse *may include obstacles etc.*

Judges Choice - Pinto ridden by riders 12 years & under – *winner receives a sash*
