INFORMATION

- This is a fun, supportive show, and a great show to meet other Pinto members. If you are unsure about anything, please ask.
- You can choose to enter your horse in either Heavyweight, Lightweight or Middleweight. If you are unsure, please enter the weight section you think your Pinto should be in and before the show starts the judge can advise you if they feel you should change sections.
- Plaiting is optional.
- Horse Registration and Membership forms are available on our website www.nzpinto.com.
- RAS Height Certificates are not required.
- Back numbers are to be supplied by the competitor.
- The show programme will be emailed.
- Age of horse is recognised as 1st August.
- Age of the Rider or Handler is as 1st August.
- The NZ Pinto Horse Society Committee reserves the right to alter or delete the programme as they see fit.
- NZ Pinto Horse Society accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to Property, Horse, Handler, Rider or Spectator
- Supreme Winners Prize Money

The NZ Pinto Horse Society offers \$300 for the **Supreme Inhand winner** and \$300 for the **Supreme Ridden winner** with a cap of \$500 if the same horse wins both. The prize is only given if the horse competes in the Pinto section at the Horse of the Year Show (HOY) 2025 in a minimum of 3 classes.

A copy of the receipt of your HOY entry must be provided to the Society Secretary. Payment will be made 5 working days after the completion of HOY 2025. Not transferable to any other horse or if the horse is sold. If the horse entered doesn't compete on the day or if HOY 2025 is cancelled the prize will not be paid unless the committee decides otherwise. If prize is not claimed by 1st March 2025 the prize is forfeited.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Horses **MUST** be registered and the owner a financial member of the NZ Pinto Horse Society at close of entries. You are able to enter with pending registrations, please write pending next to your horses name.
2. No trimming of horse's whiskers or inner ear is permitted. Refer to the RAS website for more information.
3. All riders must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when riding. Helmets must conform with one of the current approved safety standards, the list can be found at www.ras.org.nz – equestrian. All helmets must be identified by the current tag system.
4. **Colts and Stallions** 12 months and over, must be shown in a bridle and bit and Miniature horses in a halter and stallion chain.

All Colts/Stallions, except foals, must wear two official RAS or ESNZ 'S' ID badges, one attached to each side of their bridle.

The rider/handler must wear two RAS or ESNZ official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring and outside the ring they must wear an Hi Viz vest.

Pony Stallions must be ridden by riders 14 years and over also refer Novice pony rule. Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a handler/rider 17 years of age or older.

No Colts/Stallions are not to be left unattended including unattended tied to floats/trucks at any time while on the show grounds.

Colts/Stallions will be eliminated with no refund given if rule 4 is not adhered to.

5. **Novice**

Not to have won more than 5 wins in a Pinto conformation class or Best Registered Pinto class. Novice wins include all RAS affiliated shows, Horse of the Year and NZ Pinto Horse Society shows at close of entries.

Novices are eligible to enter Open classes.

Novice Ponies can be ridden by riders over 17 years in the Novice class only. They are not eligible for the Open Championship if ridden by a rider over 17 years of age.

6. **Open Ponies** must be ridden by riders 17 years and under in all classes.

7. **Protests** must be accompanied by a \$50 deposit, refundable if the protest is sustained and submitted no later than half an hour after the incident that gave rise to the protest.

8. Any competitor or spectator found mistreating a horse, competing a horse deemed to be lame by the judge, arguing/fighting or being abusive to other competitors, judges or officials will be eliminated with no refund and asked to leave the grounds immediately. This includes ringside behaviour.

9. In the event of sickness or injury, 75% of total entry fees will be refunded if a qualified Veterinarian or Doctors certificate is produced to the Show Secretary within 5 working days of the competition. No other refunds will be made.

10. Any Lapels, Badges, Rugs or similar that identify previous awards won are banned from being worn on the rider/handler or horse/pony in or near the ring.

11. An official can order any horse considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the owner/exhibitor/competitor.

12. **ALL manure/hay/rubbish must be picked up and taken with you from yards and around floats/trucks etc.**

Ring 1 - **INHAND HEAVYWEIGHT**

Heavyweight is a heavier boned horse e.g. Saddle Hunter or Cob type

- 1) Best Presented Pinto & Handler, 1st place to go forward for Champion Best Presented, judged after classes 1 & 12
- 2) Handler 17 years & under, entered in either section, class 3 will not start until both handler classes have been judged
- 3) Best Colour & Pattern, judged on markings exhibited
- 4) Best Walking
- 5) Best Trotting
- 6) Foal or Yearling, to mature over 148cm
- 7) 2 or 3 year old, to mature over 148cm

H.S Carpentry Champion & Reserve Youngstock Heavyweight Horse

judged from 1st placegetters in classes 6 & 7, 2nd placegetters to standby

- 8) Pony 3 years & under, to mature under 148cm
- 9) Pony 4 years & over, not to exceed 148cm

Champion & Reserve Heavyweight Pony

judged from 1st placegetters in classes 8 & 9, 2nd placegetters to standby

- 10) Adult 4 years & over, over 148cm but not to exceed 158cm
- 11) Adult 4 years & over, over 158cm

Desdev Ltd Champion & Reserve Adult Heavyweight Horse

judged from 1st placegetters in classes 10 & 11, 2nd placegetters to standby

Champion winners to go forward for **Supreme of Show** at end of the Inhand section

Ring 2 - **INHAND LIGHTWEIGHT and MIDDLEWEIGHT**

Lightweight is a finer type of Horse, Middleweight is a Riding Horse type

- 12) Best Presented Pinto & Handler, 1st place to go forward for Champion Best Presented, judged after classes 1 & 12
- 13) Handler 18 years & over, entered in either section, class 13 will not start until both handler classes have been judged
- 14) Best Colour & Pattern, judged on markings exhibited
- 15) Best Walking

- 16) Best Trotting
- 17) Foal or Yearling, to mature over 148cm
- 18) 2 or 3 year old, to mature over 148cm

judged from 1st placegetters in classes 17 & 18, 2nd placegetters to standby

- 19) Pony 3 years & under, to mature under 148cm

- 25) Best Paced, 1st place to go forward for Champion Paced & Mannered
- 26) Best Mannered, 1st place to go forward for Champion Paced & Mannered

- 27)** Novice Pony 0 to 5 wins, not to exceed 148cm, 1st place to go forward for Champion Novice
- 28)** Novice Heavyweight 0 to 5 wins, over 148cm, 1st place to go forward for Champion Novice
- 29)** Open Pony, not to exceed 148cm

Champion & Reserve Heavyweight Pony

judged from 1st placegetters in class 27 & 29, 2nd placegetters to standby

- 30)** Open Heavyweight Horse, over 148cm

- 35)** Novice Pony 0 to 5 wins, not to exceed 148cm, 1st place to go forward for Champion Novice
- 36)** Novice 0 to 5 wins, over 148cm, 1st place to go forward for Champion Novice
- 37)** Open Pony, not to exceed 148cm
